Gen. 1 & 2

- WILL TO OBEY. (*Gen. 1:26 – 28*)
 - God **MADE** me so I **CAN CELEBRATE WHO I AM**.
 - God **MADE** me so I **AM RESPONSIBLE TO HIM**.
 - God **MADE** me so I **HAVE UNLIMITED POSSIBILITIES**.
- WORK TO DO. (*Gen 1:28; 2:15-17*)
 - God has **PREWIRED** man for **WORK**.
 - **The opposite of WORK is LAZINESS**. (*Prov 21:25; 26:14-16*)
 - **Do you want to be a CONTRIBUTOR or CONSUMER?**
- **WOMAN TO LOVE**. (*Gen. 2:18 – 24*)
 - **To love a woman is to PROTECT her and PROVIDE for her**.
 - **He gives Adam ONE WOMAN not MULTIPLE WOMEN**.
 - **He gives Adam A WOMAN not ANOTHER MAN**.

A Boy's Transition to Adulthood (5 Sociological Variables):

1. LEAVEES his PARENTS HOME.
2. Finish his VOCATIONAL training
3. Enter his CAREER-JOB and achieve FINANCIAL INDEPENDENCE.
4. Find a WIFE.
5. Then, have CHILDREN WITH HER.

- Read the sermon text.
- Summarize the key verses from the sermon text. Tell the story in your own words.
- Share your observations from the sermon text. "What did I see?"
 - *Key Characters* (Who was speaking in the text? Who was the audience in the text?)
 - *Setting* (What is happening in this text? What are the events?)
 - *Location* (Where is the writer? Where are the people in the story?)
 - *Key words and phrases* (Why is this included? Why does this follow that?)
 - *Date* (When did the events take place? When was the writer writing?)
- Examine the sermon text. "What does it mean?"
 - What did it mean then?
 - What does it mean now?
- Find reference scriptures from the Bible that will support the sermon text.
- Share anything from the sermon text that was insightful or challenging.
- Discuss examples from the sermon or your own that would help illustrate the text.
