Mk. 12:30,31	Day 18 Pray for the appointment of Godly supreme court justices, government officials, and local leaders. We pray that they are men and women of integrity. Rom. 13:1-4	Day 19 Pray that God would Keep our nation and community safe from those that desire to do us harm. Matt. 16:18,19	Day 20 We pray for the salvation of our community and national leaders.
