

# 21 Days of Prayer & Financial Fasting

# 2024

At the beginning of each new year, we intentionally set aside 21 days to fast and pray. This year, we will participate in a financial fast: The purpose of this financial fast is to help you gain a new perspective on how you use money and gain a new level of discipline in your use of credit.

For 21 Days, you will refrain from any non--emergency or non--essential spending. An emergency (or essential item) is defined as food, hygiene, school supplies, cleaning supplies, medicine/medical supplies only.

**This fast includes:**

- No going to the mall, retail establishments, online or window shopping.
- No restaurant, carry out or delivery meals including fast food and coffee.
- No movies or purchasing gifts or gift cards.
- No credit card or debit card use. Use cash only.

(Matt. 6:33)	Day 10 Pray for a "spirit of generosity", as well as attentive to showing justice, mercy and faithfulness to those in need. (Matt. 23:23)	Day 11 Pray for God's guidance to be faithful in spending money wisely. (Matt. 25:21)	Day 12 Pray for a "spirit of generosity" in living and giving. (Luke 6:38)	Day 13 Pray that God will free you from any form of greed and the abundance of things, but rather to be rich towards Him and spiritual things. (Luke 12:13-21)	Day 14 Pray that God will teach you to focus on the eternal and not the temporal. (Luke 12:22)
Day 15 Pray to give yourself to God first and with a willing heart. (Luke 12:34)	Day 16 Pray that you will be a faithful steward over all the Lord has entrusted to you. (Luke 16:10)	Day 17 Pray to give abundantly, cheerfully, consistently, and faithfully. (2 Cor. 9:6,7)	Day 18 Pray to be generous to fellow Christians, our outreach initiatives, international visitors, missionaries and strangers in our midst. (1 Cor. 16:1)	Day 19 Pray for increased voluntary giving to the Lord's work. (1 Cor. 16:2-3)	Day 20 Pray that your love for God will always be your motivation for giving. (Mark 12:29,30)	<b>Day 21 (Jan. 28<sup>th</sup>)</b> Pray to revisit an area of your stewardship during these 21 days for confession, repentance, restoration and transformation, as a living sacrifice that will be pleasing to God (Rom. 12:1,2)
