- The FAFSA one page document (Federal Aid) must be postmarked **ON** or **BEFORE March 5, 2022.** *If not received by the stated date, you will not be considered for any financial need scholarships for the 2022-2023 school year.*

Please note that if your documentation is not received by the deadline dates stated above, **you will become ineligible for a Concord scholarship.**

2022 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS & CHECKLIST

Dear Scholarship Applicant:

To be considered for a Concord Scholarship award, your application packet must include:	<u>Use checklist to ensure all documents are included in packet</u>
1. Typed <i>application form</i> ; printed and signed for submission. HANDWRITTEN applications will not be reviewed and discarded.	
2. Three (3) <i>letters of recommendation</i> from the people listed below – Letter must be on <i>OFFICIAL LETTERHEAD OF COMPANY/ORGANIZATION</i> with the <i>PERSON'S TITLE AND THEIR RELATIONSHIP TO YOU AND WITH CURRENT DATE.</i> (No longer than one year old. ANY RECOMMENDATION LETTER FROM A RELATIVE IS UNACCEPTABLE.)	
a. Teacher/ Counselor (Current High School Students) or Employer Supervisor/ Faculty Advisor (College)	
b. Community Leader (Not high school or church).....	
c. Ministry Leader <i>other than</i> Lead Pastor/wife for Concord, Children’s, Youth, and Singles/Young Adults.....	
3. <i>Official transcripts</i> (most recent) from high school and/or college/university. If you completed college courses while enrolled in high school; or enrolled in a high school collegiate program, please submit both current high and college transcripts.	
4. Printed copy of your <i>ACT or SAT Scores</i> if graduating from high school. If you are enrolled in college or pursuing an advanced degree, no admission scores are required.	
5. Letters of Acceptance/Admission from college/university (document) indicating program acceptance for Fall 2022. REQUIRED FOR PURSUING GRADUATE /SEMINARY SCHOOL.	
6. An <i>essay</i> , 300-400 words (one page), which includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Your ministry involvement while in high school or college; ● Your educational and career goals; ● How this award will help you to achieve these goals; and ● Why should you receive this award? 	



<p>7. Submit 2022 FAFSA (federal Aid) document indicating your financial need ON or BEFORE <u>March 5, 2022</u>. If the document is not postmarked by March 5th, <u>you will not be eligible for any need-based Concord scholarships</u>. Proof of delivery confirmation or other tracking is recommended. <u>DO NOT BRING OR MAIL ANY DOCUMENT DIRECTLY TO CONCORD CHURCH.</u></p>	
<p>8. Read the Summary of Concord Scholarships thoroughly so that you will know which award you may qualify for based upon your current Grade Point Average, Admission score(s), and the information in your application.</p>	

The completed **TYPED** application with the required documents (application packet) listed above (in the box, 1-7) must be postmarked **ON or BEFORE Tuesday, FEBRUARY 15, 2022**. Proof of delivery confirmation or other tracking is recommended. **DO NOT BRING OR MAIL MATERIALS DIRECTLY TO CONCORD CHURCH.**

The application packet must be assembled in the order above:

- Completed typed application
- Current Official Transcript(s)
- Letters of recommendation (3)
- Essay
- Admission Scores, only if graduating from high school
- Acceptance letters (required for Graduate/seminary students)



CHECKLIST

NOTE THE FOLLOWING: **YOU KEEP THIS DOCUMENT **

1. **Full-time Concord staff** is not eligible for any scholarships from the Concord Scholarship Program.
2. **If you forfeit a Concord scholarship for any reason**, you are not eligible for current or future Concord scholarships.
3. **Any student (undergraduate/graduate) graduating in the Fall 2022 semester**, you are not eligible for a Concord scholarship.
4. **If FASFA one page document is not received by March 5, 2022**, you will **not be considered for any need- based Concord scholarship and not receive any points.**
5. **An applicant must attend one of the Application Overviews and points for his/her full attendance will be awarded.**
6. **Only applicants selected as candidates for an award** will be interviewed as part of the selection process.
7. **Only ONE Concord scholarship** will be awarded to any Concord Scholar in an academic year.
8. If award is more than \$1,000, the scholarships will be equally divided for two terms of enrollment for the year.
9. **FOR UNDERGRADUATES:** The maximum number of scholarships that any Concord Scholar can be awarded from Concord Church is **TWO (2)** **OR** the **MAXIMUM** amount of scholarship funding awarded is \$15,000.
10. **FOR GRADUATE/SEMINARY:** scholarships for graduate/professional degree seeking study will be awarded **for part or full-time study** and equally divided for two terms of enrollment for one academic year if applicable.
11. **FOR GRADUATE/SEMINARY:** The maximum number of scholarships that any Concord Graduate Scholar can be awarded from Concord Church is **TWO (2)** **OR** the **MAXIMUM** amount of scholarship funding awarded is \$2,000.
Other guidelines are applicable for female seminary students.
12. **Any check payment will be made payable to the school and student and certified mailed to the school.**
