





2. When was the last time that you were quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to become angry? How did you think the outcome of the situation changed?




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3. What are dangers of being listeners of the word and not doers? How would a parent react to a child who heard a command but did not act on the command?




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4. James suggests that we must do what the words says. We usually obey out of faith or fear. Why do you think faith and fear are mentioned so often in scripture?
